By Mr. Rosenberg, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2093) of Stanley C. Rosenberg and Denise Andrews for legislation to authorize the town of Erving to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises. An Act authorizing the town of Erving to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the town of Erving may grant a license for the sale of all alcoholic
3 beverages not to be drunk on the premises to Weatherheads located at 63 French King Highway
4 in the town of Erving under section 15 of said chapter 138. The license shall be subject to all of
5 said chapter 138 except said section 17.

6 (b) The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other
7 location but it may grant the license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files
8 with the authority a letter from the department of revenue indicating that the license is in good
9 standing with the department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

10 (c) If the license granted under this act is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it shall
11 be returned physically with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto to

12 the licensing authority which may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same location
13 under the same conditions as specified in this act.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
