Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 An Act Designating The Red-Bellied Cooter As The Official Turtle Of The
3 Commonwealth.

4 Section 60. The Red-Bellied Cooter (*Pseudemys Rubriventris*) shall be named the official
5 turtle of the Commonwealth.
