An Act relative to special education enrollment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 70 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the third and fourth definitions and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following definitions:- "Assumed tuitioned-out special education enrollment",
- 4 the prior 5 year district average percentage of students included in foundation enrollments on
- 5 Special Education Individual Education Plan whom the district has placed in out of district
- 6 placements.
- 7 "Assumed in school special education enrollment", the prior 5 year district
- 8 average percentage of students included in foundation enrollments on Special Education
- 9 Individual Education Plans who attend district schools.
