An Act designating a portion of the route 128 extension in the city of Gloucester as the Purple Heart Highway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The length of highway, currently referred to as the Route 128 extension,  
2   that runs between Grant Circle at Washington Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 1.6  
3   miles to its intersection with East Main Street and Bass Avenue in the city of Gloucester, shall be  
4   designated and known as the Purple Heart Highway in honor of the brave recipients of the Purple  
5   Heart. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable  
6   markers bearing that designation in compliance with applicable state and federal standards.
