By Mr. Brownsberger, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2306) of William N. Brownsberger for legislation to authorize the lease of the Daly field complex located in the Brighton section of the city of Boston. State Administration and Regulatory Oversight.

An Act authorizing the lease of the Daly field complex located in the Brighton section of the city of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the 1 2 contrary, the following entity shall have all the rights, powers and responsibilities enumerated 3 herein: the Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. is a private, charitable, non-profit 4 corporation created by articles of organization; duly filed with the secretary of state's office on August 29, 2011. The Daly Field complex shall be used for community, high school and 5 6 collegiate athletic events, including tennis, football, softball, soccer, rugby, running, field 7 hockey, lacrosse, crew, and other athletic events as determined by the board of directors of 8 Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. Nothing in this act shall be construed as 9 establishing the Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. as a governmental body. 10 SECTION 2. The Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. shall be governed by a 11 board of directors consisting of: 15 members, 2 of whom shall be appointed by the governor, 12 including 1 of whom shall be the commissioner of the department of conservation and recreation

13 or a designee; 3 of whom shall be appointed by the president of Simmons College, including 1 14 who shall serve as the chair of the board; 4 of whom shall be appointed by the principal of 15 Brighton high school; 2 of whom shall be residents of the Allston Brighton sections of the city of 16 Boston, including 1 whom shall be selected by the state representative representing the 17 seventeenth Suffolk district, and 1 whom shall be selected by the state representative 18 representing the eighteenth Suffolk district; 1 of whom shall be selected by the state senator 19 representing the second Suffolk and Middlesex district; 1 of whom shall be selected by the 20 executive director of Community Rowing, Incorporated; 1 of whom shall be selected by the 21 president of the Charles River Conservancy; and 1 of whom shall be appointed by the 22 Headmistress of Newton Country Day School of the Sacred Heart, to oversee the continued use, 23 daily operation and maintenance of the fields and facilities together with the land and 24 appurtenances known as the Daly Field complex. Members of the board shall be appointed for a 25 term of 3 years with no limit on the number of terms they may serve; provided, however, 26 members appointed by the governor shall serve for a term coterminous with that of the governor. 27 Members shall hold office until a successor is appointed.

28 Except as hereinafter provided, the department of conservation and recreation shall 29 determine and schedule the use of the fields, facilities, land and appurtenances of the Daly Field 30 complex. The department of conservation and recreation shall ensure fair and reasonable use of 31 the fields, facilities, land and appurtenances for practice and games based upon the needs of 32 Simmons College, the Allston, Brighton, and abutting communities, including Allston-Brighton Little League, Incorporated, Brighton high school football, and public schools and youth sports 33 34 leagues from the Allston, Brighton, and abutting communities. The department of conservation 35 and recreation shall make every effort to balance the allocation of practice and game needs of

36 Simmons College, the Allston, Brighton, and abutting communities, including Allston-Brighton 37 Little League, Incorporated, and Brighton high school football in a manner that provides equal 38 opportunity, time and access. The department of conservation and recreation shall guarantee 39 adequate field time to meet the program needs of Simmons College and the needs of Brighton 40 high school football. The community needs, including Allston-Brighton Little League, 41 Incorporated and public schools and youth sports leagues from the Allston, Brighton, and 42 abutting communities, shall also be accommodated by the department of conservation and 43 recreation. Field needs shall include Simmons College practice and game time reserved on the 44 full Daly Field complex during weekdays from 5:30 P.M. to 9:30 P.M, from March to May, 45 inclusive and mid August to November, inclusive; provided that Brighton high school football 46 shall have reserved field time on Friday evenings from mid August to November, inclusive, 47 Allston-Brighton Little League, Incorporated, shall have reserved field time during weekdays 48 from 5:30 to 8:30 P.M., inclusive, from May to July, inclusive. Brighton high school football 49 shall have reserved field time during weekdays from 2:30 P.M. to 5:30 P.M., inclusive, and on 50 Friday evenings from mid August to November, inclusive. Saturdays shall be time reserved for and shared between Simmons College and the Allston, Brighton, and abutting communities and 51 52 permitted through the department of conservation and recreation. Sundays shall be reserved for 53 the Allston, Brighton, and abutting communities and permitted through the department of 54 conservation and recreation. Any reserved times contained herein shall not be changed without 55 the approval of the entity having the benefit of the reservation. Parties with reserved times shall 56 notify the department of conservation and recreation of changes in usage or non-usage to 57 maximize public use of the field or Daly Field complex. The department of conservation and 58 recreation shall make every reasonable effort to permit during the reserved times if the field or

59 Daly Field complex are not being used by the above named parties. During all times when the 60 department of conservation and recreation does not permit usage of the field or the Daly Field 61 complex, the field and Daly Field complex shall remain open and accessible for informal 62 recreational usage by the general public. The board and the department of conservation and 63 recreation may review reserved times at board meetings or otherwise to maximize field use. All 64 remaining practice and game times shall be determined by the department of conservation and 65 recreation, in consultation with the board. The department of conservation and recreation shall 66 issue a report on the usage of the Daly Field complex and shall biannually file the report with the 67 Daly Field complex board of directors and elected officials in the Massachusetts legislature 68 representing Allston, Brighton, and abutting communities on or before January 1st and July 1st. 69 Brighton high school football, Allston-Brighton Little League, Incorporated, and public schools 70 and youth sports leagues from the Allston, Brighton, and abutting communities shall not be 71 responsible for any operating or use permit costs associated with the Daly Field complex. 72 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding sections 40E to 40 I, inclusive, of chapter 7 of the General 73 Laws or any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the commissioner of 74 division of capital asset management and maintenance may, in consultation with the

commissioner of the department of conservation and recreation, enter into one 20 year lease and may enter into one 10 year extension thereafter with the Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. for the fields and facilities together with the land and appurtenances of the Daly Field complex which is located east of the Daly Memorial Rink and west of the public launching ramp parking lot on Nonantum Road in the Brighton section of the city of Boston. Simmons College shall be responsible for all costs and expenses, including costs associated with any engineering, surveys, appraisals and lease preparation related to the 20 year lease, the one 10 year extension

82 or other agreements authorized under this act. The one 10 year extension shall be automatically 83 granted if Simmons College makes a significant investment in the Daly Field complex within the 84 final years of the lease, if necessary, as determined by the department of conservation and 85 recreation.

86 The 20 year lease shall provide for the fields and facilities together with the land and 87 appurtenances, and a newly constructed or repaired synthetic turf field, synthetic football field, 88 running track, tennis courts, lighting for the entire parcel, bleacher seating for all fields, tennis 89 courts, and facilities to accommodate river access for crew and buildings, including press boxes, 90 home and visitor locker rooms, ticket booths, storage, concessions, and a path along the shore of 91 the Charles River extending from west of Daly Rink to the public access path at Community 92 Rowing, Incorporated immediately east of the Daly Field complex. The department of 93 conservation and recreation shall maintain this path. Simmons College, in consultation with the 94 department of conservation and recreation and the board of directors of the Allston Brighton 95 Friends of Daly Field, Inc., shall manage and oversee the construction, refurbishment, repair and 96 improvement to the fields and facilities of the Daly Field complex. Simmons College shall be 97 responsible for all costs and expenses associated with any engineering, surveys, appraisals, 98 construction, refurbishment, repair and improvements to the Daly Field complex; provided, that 99 Simmons College expends approximately \$5,000,000 on the construction, refurbishment, repair 100 and improvements. Simmons College, in conjunction with the department of conservation and 101 recreation, shall conduct a traffic and parking study at the Daly Field complex and shall report 102 findings to the department of conservation and recreation, which will then distribute such 103 findings to elected officials in the Massachusetts legislature representing the Allston, Brighton, 104 and abutting communities who will then have 30 days thereafter to comment to the department

of conservation and recreation. The construction, refurbishment and repair of all fields, facilities,
land and appurtenances shall, where applicable, meet National Collegiate Athletic Association
rules, regulations and standards. The department of conservation and recreation shall have
approval over the construction, refurbishment, repair and improvements to the Daly Field
complex and Charles River path to ensure that Simmons College satisfies the provisions of this
paragraph.

111 Notwithstanding sections 40E to 40I, inclusive, of chapter 7 of the General Laws or any 112 other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the 20 year lease, and the 10 year 113 extension and other agreements executed under this section shall be on terms, conditions and 114 consideration acceptable to the commissioner of the division of capital asset management and 115 maintenance, in consultation with the commissioner of the department of conservation and 116 recreation; provided, however, that the 20 year lease, and the 10 year extension and other 117 agreements shall provide that: (i) the Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. shall oversee 118 land, facilities, fields and appurtenances associated therewith during the term of the 20 year 119 lease and one 10 year extension; (ii) the Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. shall carry 120 comprehensive general liability insurance naming the commonwealth as a co-insured, protecting 121 the commonwealth against all claims for personal injury or property damage arising from land 122 and appurtenances associated therewith during the term of the lease; provided, that Simmons 123 College shall be responsible for all costs and expenses associated with carrying comprehensive 124 general liability insurance; (iii) the Daly Field complex shall be accessible to the general public 125 when not in use by permitees; (iv) the lessee shall be responsible for outreach and stewardship; 126 (v) the Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. shall not design or construct any facilities on 127 the parcel without the written approval of the commissioner of the department of capital asset

management and maintenance and the commissioner of the department of conservation and recreation;(vi) Simmons College shall be responsible for utility costs, subject to the 20 year lease and the one 10 year extension, and general day-to-day maintenance of the Daly Field complex; and (vii) Simmons College shall be responsible for the maintenance of the synthetic surface it shall install on the field.

133 The 20 year lease and the one 10 year lease extension shall be reviewed by the inspector 134 general for comment and recommendation. The division of capital asset management and 135 maintenance shall file any proposed construction or repairs to any facilities, with the house and 136 senate clerks, who shall forward the same to the joint committee on state administration and 137 regulatory oversight, the state representative from the seventeenth Suffolk district, the state 138 representative from the eighteenth Suffolk district and the state senator from the second Suffolk 139 and Middlesex district 60 days prior to the effective date of the proposed construction, repairs, 140 lease extension or any other agreement.

Before entering into the 20 year lease, the one 10 year extension or other any agreement under this act the commissioner of capital asset management and maintenance shall, in consultation with the commissioner of the department of conservation and recreation, determine the exact boundaries of the Daly Field complex after completion of a survey.

The Board of Trustees of Simmons College shall contribute \$500,000 to the department of conservation and recreation for the sole purpose of funding a portion of the Watertown Riverfront Park Restoration Project along Charles River Road in the town of Watertown, to be paid as follows: \$250,000 at the time of execution of the 20 year lease, and \$250,000 upon issuance of all permits required to proceed with construction.

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, any agreements provided for under this act relating to the advertising, bidding or award of contracts, the procurement of services or to the construction and design of improvements shall not be applicable to Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc.

154 SECTION 5. If the land, facilities, fields and appurtenances comprising the Daly Field 155 complex cease to be used by the Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. for the purposes 156 and in the manner described in this act or if the Allston Brighton Friends of Daly Field, Inc. 157 cease to be the lessee at any time before July 31, 2043, the Daly Field complex shall revert to 158 the commonwealth upon such terms and conditions as the commissioner of division of capital 159 asset management and maintenance may determine, and shall be assigned to the care, custody 160 and control of the department of conservation and recreation. Should the Daily Field complex 161 revert to the commonwealth, any further disposition thereof shall be subject to the provisions of 162 40E to 40J, inclusive, of chapter 7 of the General Laws.

163 SECTION 6. This act shall expire on July 31st 2043".
