An Act establishing a sick leave bank for June Graham, an employee of the Department of Public Health.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for June Graham, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2   department of public health of the commonwealth shall establish a sick leave bank for June  
3   Graham, an employee of the department of public health. Any employee of the department of  
4   public health may contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for  
5   use by June Graham. Upon such time as said June Graham’s termination of employment with  
6   said department of public health or requests to dissolve said sick bank the balance of sick leave  
7   shall be transferred to the department of public health paid leave bank.
