An Act relative to certain land in Templeton under the control of the Department of Mental Retardation..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the land  
2 purchased under chapter 64 of the resolves of 1897, presently being used by the Templeton  
3 Developmental Center under the control of the department of developmental services, shall be  
4 used only for the care and education of the developmentally disabled.
