An Act relative to the transfer of funds for recovery high schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 91 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting the following new section:-

3           (e) Failure by a school district to transfer funds to a Recovery High School as required in  
4 subsection (b) shall result in a deduction of the amount therein from the home school district's  
5 Chapter 70 funding for the following year.
