The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to election officers..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 54 Section 11 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
 the words "one warden, one deputy warden, one clerk, one deputy clerk, four inspectors and four
 deputy inspectors" and replacing it with "a minimum of one warden, one clerk, two inspectors
 and a ballot box inspector".

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 54 Section 12 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking 6 the words "one warden, one deputy warden, one clerk, one deputy clerk, two inspectors and two 7 deputy inspectors" and replacing it with "a minimum of one warden, one clerk, two inspectors 8 and a ballot box inspector".

9 SECTION 3. Chapter 54 Section 67 of the General Laws as amended by the Acts of
10 2004, c. 334, Section 34 is hereby amended by deleting the section and replacing it with the

following: "The voting list shall be delivered to the warden at the entrance to the precinct in the 11 polling place. When a ballot is delivered to a voter, his name shall be checked on the voting list 12 at the entrance of the precinct. One inspector in charge of the voting list and the inspector in 13 14 charge of the ballot box shall be of different political parties. The ballot box inspector shall 15 insure that each voter casts a ballot into the ballot box before exiting the precinct. No person 16 shall vote if his name is not on the voting list, nor until the inspector shall check his name 17 thereon, unless he presents a certificate from the registrars of the voters as provided by section 18 fifty-one or section fifty-nine of Chapter fifty-one, or unless he is voting by provisional ballot 19 under section 76C".

20 SECTION 4. Chapter 54 Section 83 of the General Laws is hereby amended by deleting
21 the entire section.
