## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to emergency aid to the elderly, disabled and children..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law or regulation to the contrary, the
2	Department of Transitional Assistance is hereby authorized and directed to conduct a study
3	relative to benefits under the Emergency Aid to the Elderly, Disabled and Children (EAEDC)
4	program. Said study will examine cost of living factors including but not limited to housing,
5	food, transportation, clothing, and healthcare, and assess the need for an increase in EAEDC
6	benefits.
7	The results of said study shall be submitted to the Chairman of the Senate
8	Committee on Ways and Means, the Chairman of the House Committee on Ways and Means,
9	and the House and Senate Chairmen of the Joint Committee on Elder Affairs no later than March
10	31, 2012.
