An Act requiring equal benefits for all new mothers..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 105D of chapter 149 of the 2004 Official Edition of the  
2   general laws is hereby amended by adding after the word "leave.", in line 13, the following  
3   language:-

4                   "An employee on maternity leave for the adoption of a child shall be entitled to the same  
5   benefits offered by her employer as an employee on maternity leave for the birth of a child."
