Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 32D of Chapter 140 of the General Laws as so appearing
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following new paragraph:--
- Violations of this section shall be met with a fee to be determined by the manufactured
- 4 housing commission.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 32G of Chapter 140 of the General Laws as so appearing
- 6 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 43, the words "ten nor more than one hundred" and
- 7 inserting in place thereof the following:--
