An Act relative to judgment and execution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 34. Chapter 235 is amended by amending the following language in
- 2 Section 34 as follows:
- 3 SECTION 34. Fourteenth, Estates of homestead as defined in chapter one
- 4 hundred and eighty-eight or, in lieu thereof, the amount of money each rental period, not
- 5 exceeding one thousand two hundred dollars per month, necessary to pay the rent for the
- 6 dwelling unit occupied by him and his family.
- 7 SECTION 34. Sixteenth, An automobile necessary for personal transportation
- 8 or to secure or maintain employment, not exceeding three thousand two hundred-fifty dollars in
- 9 value. Notwithstanding any other section or subsection of this Chapter 235 or Chapter 188, this
- 10 Section 34 of Chapter 235 shall be subordinate to, and shall include any and all exemptions
- 11 provided in 11 U.S.C. § 522(c) and 11 U.S.C. § 522(f).
