An Act exempting law enforcement officers from jury duty.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, section 1 of  
2 chapter 234 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 official edition, is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the word “orders” in line 21 the following:- ;law enforcement professionals,  
4 including municipal police officers, state troopers, federal agents and correctional officers.
