An Act relative to the proximity of storage facilities utilized in possession of land or tenement cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 4 of chapter 239 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 393 of the acts of 2010, is hereby further amended by striking out
3 the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following three sentences:--

4 For the purposes of this section a "licensed public warehouse" is a warehouse licensed
5 and bonded pursuant to section 1 of chapter 105 as set forth in Section 4 (b). In addition, a
6 "licensed public warehouse" and "a warehouse or other storage facility of the defendant's
7 choosing" shall be located in the commonwealth and within a 20 mile radius of the land or
8 tenements from which the personal property is removed. In circumstances where a licensed
9 public warehouse is designated for the storage of the defendant's personal property and no
10 licensed public warehouse is located within a 20 mile radius of the land or tenements from
11 which the personal property is removed, the officer shall cause it to be stored in the licensed
12 public warehouse closest to the land or tenements from which the personal property is removed.
