- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of Chapter 202 is hereby amended by deleting in the
- 2 first sentence the words:- or in the case of a person incapacitated by reason of mental
- 3 illness.Section 12 of Chapter 202 is hereby further amended by deleting in the first sentence the
- 4 words:- or in the case of a person incapacitated by reason of mental illness to the department of
- 5 mental health.
