Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 24G of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of subsection (c) the
- 3 following:-
- 4 Sentencing of imprisonment for the conviction of a violation of subsection (a) or (b) shall
- 5 be served consecutively to and not concurrent with convictions of operating a motor vehicle after
- 6 revocation or suspension of his or her license, and prior to the restoration of such license or right
- 7 to operate or the issuance to him or her of a new license or right to operate.
