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**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act relative to the definition of methylenedioxy methamphetamine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 31 of Chapter 94c of the General laws is hereby amended  
2 by striking Subsections (a)(5)-(8) under the Class B schedule in their entirety and replacing them  
3 with the following new subsections under the Class B schedule:-

4                   “(f) Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material,  
5 compound, mixture or preparation that contains any quantity of the following substances  
6 including salts, isomers and salts of isomers whenever the existence of such salts, isomers and  
7 salts of isomer is possible within the specific chemical designations:

- 8                   (1) Phenyl-2-propanone (p2p)  
9                   (2) Phenylcyclohexylamine (PCH)  
10                  (3) Piperidinocyclohexanecarbonitrile (PCC)  
11                  (4) 3, 4 methylenedioxy methamphetamine (MDMA)”

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
