An Act relative to the sale of alcohol on election day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 33 of chapter 130 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 official edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 1 through 9 the following sentence: -

3           No licensee under section 15 shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages, and no registered  
4 pharmacist acting under section 29 and no licensee under section 30A shall sell alcoholic  
5 beverages or alcohol without a physician’s prescription, during polling hours on any day in  
6 which a state or municipal election, caucus or primary is held in a city or town in which such  
7 licensed place is conducted; provided that these restrictions shall not apply if the local licensing  
8 authority issues an order to that effect applicable alike to all licensees of every class subject to  
9 such restrictions.
