## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to anti-freeze and engine coolant.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, section 303N
- 2 of chapter 94 of the Massachusetts general laws shall apply to wholesale containers of engine
- 3 coolant or anti-freeze containing 55 gallons or more of engine coolant or anti-freeze.
