Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 25C of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008

- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (5), by striking out in the first sentence the
- 3 words, "a fine of not more than one thousand five hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not
- 4 more than one year, or both", and inserting in place thereof the following:- imprisonment in the
- 5 state prison for not more than 5 years or by imprisonment in jail for not less than 6 months nor
- 6 more than 2 1/2 years or by a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$10,000, or by both such
- 7 fine and imprisonment.
