An Act relative to paying prevailing wages to tree maintenance workers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 26 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "construction of public works",  
3 in line 19, the following words:- "and in the trimming or cutting of trees on public property".

4           SECTION 2. Section 27 of chapter 149, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting  
5 after the words "fill from such site", in line 7, the following words:- " , and the trimming or  
6 cutting of trees on public property ".
