Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 18 of Chapter 12C is amended by adding the following after the
2 first sentence:-

3 For providers and provider organizations, excessive spending shall be determined based
4 on the increase in the provider’s or provider organization’s health status adjusted total medical
5 expense in excess of: (a) the cost growth benchmark divided by (b) the provider’s or the
6 provider organization’s relative price.
