An Act relative to the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the state  
2 universities and  
3           community colleges, with the approval of the executive office for administration and  
4 finance and the board of higher education, may borrow an amount not to exceed \$200,000,000 in  
5 the aggregate through the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency or any other authorized  
6 funding source for support of capital projects at their campuses, including costs associated with  
7 planning and studies, dispositions, acquisition of land and buildings and interests therein by  
8 purchase and for the preparation of plans and specifications, repairs, construction, renovations,  
9 improvements, maintenance and repair, asset management and demolition, provided that any  
10 such project shall have undergone a project study by the division of capital asset management  
11 and maintenance; any such project shall also be considered eligible for financing by the  
12 Massachusetts State College Building Authority as a project within the meaning of chapter 703  
13 of the acts of 1963.
