Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 16 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-

The John and Abigail Adams scholarship program administered by the Board of Education shall not award scholarships to any student whose family's income exceeds \$250,000 per year.
