The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen
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An Act relative to public housing restrictions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 32 of chapter 121B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Notwithstanding any general or special law or regulation to the contrary, an applicant for
4 assisted housing under this chapter who is not eligible for federal assisted housing under 42
5 U.S.C. section 1436a, and who is not a person residing in the United States as defined in
6 regulations of the federal Department of Health and Human Services, shall not displace or be
7 given priority over any applicant who is so eligible.
