An act relative to children in protective custody.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 39H of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
2 chapter 240 of the acts of 2011, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:-
- 3 Nothing in this section shall prevent a police officer from placing a minor into protective
4 custody under the provisions of section 8 of chapter 111B.
