Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1: The General Laws are hereby amended by inserting after chapter 117A the

4 Residency Requirements for Public Benefits

5 Section 1. Self declaration of residency shall not be accepted as a valid form of residency
6 verification for people seeking taxpayer-funded individual benefits from the Commonwealth of
7 Massachusetts. “.
