The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to civil infractions for juveniles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of the second paragraph of section 23 of chapter 90 of
2 the General Laws, appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the words, “not more than \$500”, the following:-

4 ; provided further, that notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a
5 finding of delinquency shall not be entered against any person against whom such a complaint
6 has been issued

7 SECTION 2. The fourth paragraph of section 34J of said chapter 90 of the General
8 Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:-

9 ; provided further, that notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any
10 person who violates this section and has not been previously determined responsible for or
11 convicted therefor, or against whom a finding of delinquency or a finding of sufficient facts to
12 support a conviction has not previously been rendered, shall not have a finding of delinquency
13 entered against him

14 SECTION 3. Section 52 of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
15 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the definition of “Delinquent Child” in the
16 second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following new definition:-

17 “Delinquent Child”, a child between seven and eighteen who commits any offense
18 against a law of the commonwealth, provided however, that such offense shall not include a civil
19 infraction, a violation of any municipal ordinance or town by-law, or a misdemeanor for which
20 the punishment is a fine, imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for not more than six
21 months, or both such fine and imprisonment.

22 SECTION 4. Said section 52 of said chapter is hereby further amended by inserting at the
23 end thereof the following new definition:-

24 “Civil Infraction”, a violation for which a civil proceeding is allowed, and for which the
25 court shall not appoint counsel, or sentence any term of incarceration.

26 SECTION 5. Section 53 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
27 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new
28 clause:-

29 (c) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any person who violates
30 clause (a) or (b) of this section shall not have a finding of delinquency entered against him.

31 SECTION 6. Paragraph 1 of section 70C of chapter 277 of the General Laws, as
32 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in the second sentence
33 the words:- “chapter 119,”
