Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of paragraph (4) of subsection (A) of section 3 of chapter 90C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentences:- If the clerk magistrate finds that the accused violator is not responsible for the citation, the \$25 fee shall be returned by the court to the accused violator. If the Justice finds that the accused violator is not responsible for the citation, the \$50.00 fee shall be returned by the court to the accused violator.
