An Act relative to wiretapping in the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subparagraph 1 of paragraph D of section 99 of chapter 272 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following  
3 clause:- g. for a person not acting under color of law to intercept a wire communication  
4 containing a person's speech or oral communication where such person is a party to the  
5 communication or where one of the parties to the communication has given prior consent to such  
6 interception, unless such communication is intercepted for the purpose of committing any  
7 criminal or tortious act in violation of the constitution or laws of the United States or State of  
8 Massachusetts or for the purpose of committing any other injurious act.
