An Act to make juvenile court custody orders fully enforceable.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 26 of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new
subsection:-

4 (d) The probate and family court department shall have exclusive jurisdiction to modify 5 or enforce an order entered under chapter 119 awarding permanent legal custody of a child to the 6 child's parent to the same extent that it has jurisdiction over a complaint for modification or 7 enforcement of a foreign judgment.
