**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act Updating Chapter 268 Section 33.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1-

2 Section 33 of Chapter 268 is hereby amended by inserting after the words, “or examiner,  
3 investigator or other officer of the department of revenue,” the following:

4 or an agent, officer, or inspector of the state department of public health or a local board  
5 of health,

6 SECTION 2-

7 Section 33 of Chapter 268 is hereby amended by striking the words, “shall be punished  
8 by a fine of not more than four hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more than one year,”  
9 and inserting in place thereof the following:

10 shall be punished by a fine of not more than four thousand dollars or by imprisonment for  
11 not more than one year
