## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to surety bond requirements for veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

Chapter 205 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official edition, is hereby
 amended by striking out section 9 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 9. Sureties on probate bonds shall be inhabitants of the commonwealth, and
satisfactory to the judge or register; except that companies permitted by section 105 of chapter

5 175 to act as sureties may be accepted in accordance with the provisions thereof.
