*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Notwithstanding section 39 of chapter 207 of the General Laws regulating the number of
- 2 justices of the peace that may be designated, the governor may designate an additional justice of
- 3 the peace in the town of Westwood to solemnize marriages under said section 39.
