An Act relative to manslaughter..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in 2010  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:-  
3           “A corporation committing manslaughter shall be punished by a fine of not more than  
4   \$250,000.”
