An Act to protect the community against sex offenders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 178 3/4 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by c. 256 of  
2 the Acts of 2010, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “offender” the following  
3 words:- “who is on probation or parole supervision.”
