## In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to the protection of persons with disabilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 22 C , the following new section:

Section 22D. Whoever has sexual intercourse or unnatural sexual intercourse with a person with disability, as defined in section 13 K , and compels such a person with disability to submit by force and against his or her will or compels such a person with disability to submit by threat of bodily injury, shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for life or for any terms of years. A prosecution commenced under this section shall neither be continued without a finding nor placed on file.
