# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to oil spills on public ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:—

2 Section 37. Any commercial motor vehicle or trailer used to deliver gasoline, oil or other 3 flammable material which causes a spill in excess of 100 gallons on any way as defined in 4 section one of chapter 90 shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$10,000 for each such 5 spill. Said penalty shall be in addition to liability for costs incurred by the Commonwealth or any 6 political subdivision thereof on cleaning and removing such spill. The superior court department 7 of the trial court shall have jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this section. Any civil 8 penalty imposed under the provisions of this section shall be paid over to the treasury of the city 9 or town wherein the spill took place.
