An Act relative to stolen animals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 112 of the General laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 58B the
2 following section:-

3 Section 58C. Any veterinarian who treats an animal in veterinary hospital or clinic shall
4 scan sick animal for a microchip I.D. to identify the animal to detriment it is not stolen. If the
5 animal is determined to have been stolen. Police shall be notified and the person in possession of
6 the animal shall be charged with receiving stolen property.
