An Act relative to the reform of archaic laws implicating certain private consensual intimate conduct between adults.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 34 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
- 2           SECTION 2. Section 35 of chapter 272 is hereby repealed.
