An Act to strengthen felony motor vehicle homicide penalties.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Section 24G of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking, in lines 14-17 of paragraph (a), the words:- “or by imprisonment in a jail or house of  
3 correction for not less than one year nor more than two and one-half years and a fine of not more  
4 than five thousand dollars.”

5           SECTION 2:

6           Section 24G of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking, in line 18  
7 of paragraph (a), the word:- “one” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- “two and  
8 one-half.”

9           SECTION 3:

10           Section 24G of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking, in line 21  
11 of paragraph (a), the word:- “one” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- “two and  
12 one-half.”
