An Act relative to the protection of public safety officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 268 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 15A the following new section:-

3 Section 15B. Any prisoner or inmate of any penal or correctional facility in the  
4 commonwealth, whether being held in custody for a court appearance, or committed to any penal  
5 or correctional facility in the commonwealth under a lawful order of a court, who is found in  
6 possession of a handcuff key shall be punished by imprisonment in a jail or house of correction  
7 for a term of 1 year.
