In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act clarifying the technical definition of a dangerous weapon in a school zone.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of Chapter 269 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended in subsection (j) by inserting following the words “by whatever means,” the
3 words:-

4 “and ‘dangerous weapon’ shall mean any other instrument reasonably believed to cause
5 bodily harm.”
