Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 58 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 34, the word "and";
- and further, section 58 of chapter 276, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 35, after the word, "conviction" the following words:-
- 5 ", and whether the person is a citizen or has been granted legal alien status in the United 6 States."
