# The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act incorporating carsharing in smart growth planning.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 40R, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is
 hereby amended by inserting the following definition:-

3 "Carsharing organization," means a corporation or cooperative that owns a fleet of one or
4 more cars parked in common areas and retains a membership base that has exclusive access to
5 the fleet on a timed basis. The registrar of motor vehicles shall promulgate regulations to further
6 define "carsharing organization" as necessary.

7 SECTION 2. Section 1 of said chapter is hereby amended by inserting after the word
8 "choices," on line 9 the following words:-

9 "including carsharing,"
