Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 16 of chapter 136 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the sentence "the performance of labor, business and work directly connected to retail sales on these days shall also be allowed" the following:
