By Mr. Winslow of Norfolk, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1781) of Daniel B. Winslow and James R. Miceli for legislation to establish a civilian conservation corps promoting community service by the long-term unemployed. Labor and Workforce Development.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act promoting community service by the long-term unemployed through a civilian conservation corps.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following paragraph:-

3 (d) Any person who has received unemployment insurance benefits for more than 180
4 days in any 365 day period shall be required to perform 8 hours weekly of public community
5 service under the supervision of the executive office of environmental affairs as part of a civilian
6 conservation corps, as a condition of receiving continued unemployment insurance benefits. For
7 purposes of administering this section, the secretary of the executive office of environmental
8 affairs may enter into agreements with any other state or municipal agency for the deployment,
9 management and supervision of the community service volunteers.
