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**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**  
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An Act relative to behavioral health managed care organizations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 113 of Chapter 58 of the Acts of 2006 is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:-

3 The terms and conditions of contracts, including financial arrangements, between any  
4 managed care organization and any specialty behavioral health managed care organization shall  
5 be subject to section 10 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official  
6 Edition.
