Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Whenever the operation of a permanent entertainment venue with seating for thirty thousand or more persons is subcontracted for a single use event from an existing user or owner, the duration of operation of its parking areas shall be limited to a period of 2 hours prior to the start time of the event through 2 hours following the end of the event, excluding any educational venue or a venue that is subcontracted out for a high school, college or university event.
